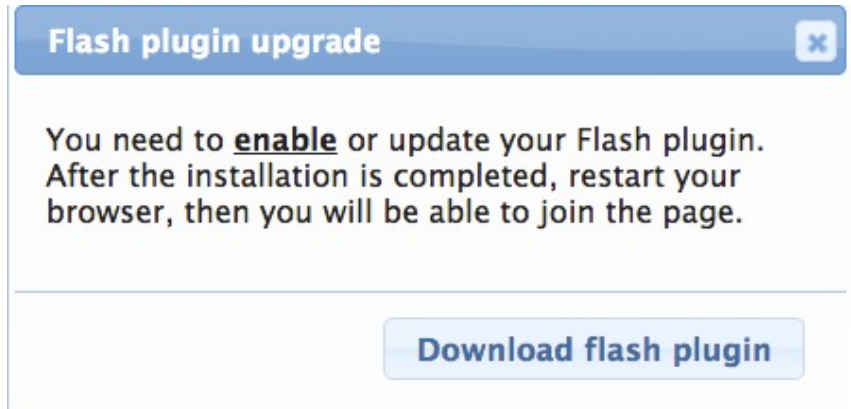
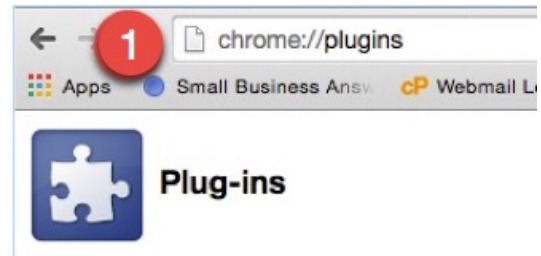

1. In your address bar in Chrome, type: **chrome://plugins**



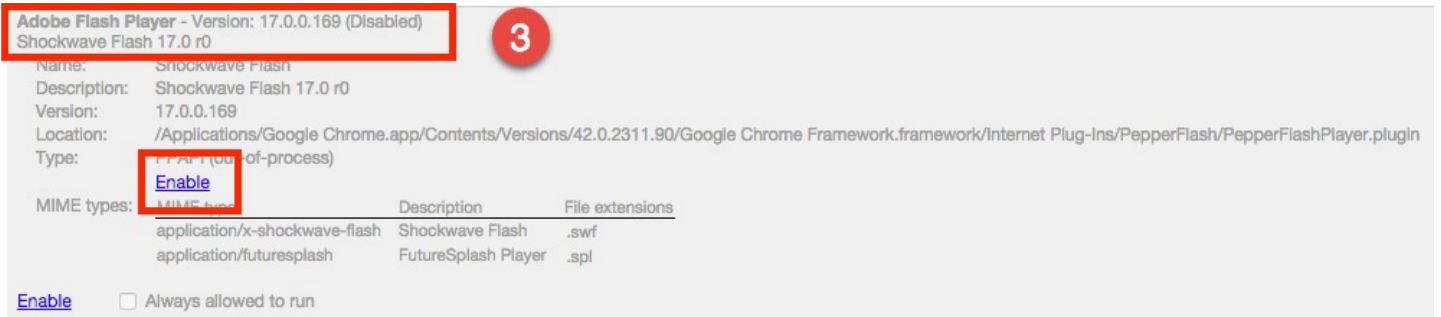
2. If not expanded, click + to open the Details page.



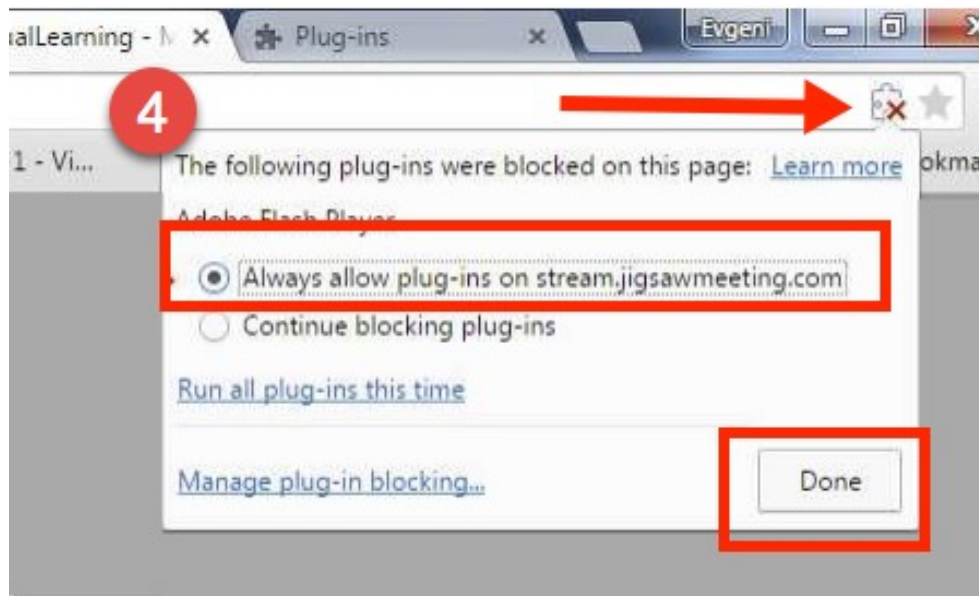
