

How To Add An Exception To Your Popup Blocker

- From the Google Chrome navigation menu select the “**tools**” button on the right side of the screen.
- Select “**Settings**” from the dropdown menu.
- Scroll down to the bottom and select “**Show advanced settings**”.

Allow all sites to show pop-ups


Do not allow any site to show pop-ups (recommended)

Earlier Versions of Google Chrome

Click the Wrench Menu Tools  → Options → Under the Hood → Privacy Content Settings → Pop-ups: Manage Exceptions → Type the list above separately and select “allow”.
